

COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES

English adjectives come in three forms. The positive; BIG, the comparative, when you compare two things: BIGGER, and the superlative, when something is more than anything else: THE BIGGEST. If adjectives have more than 2 syllables we use MORE and THE MOST.

A **big** dog. My dog is **bigger** than yours. It was **the biggest** dog I had ever seen.

The **beautiful** flower. This flower is **more beautiful** than that one. It is **the most beautiful** flower in the garden.

We used the superlative to make categories for our awards ceremony.
