- 4. Is your dinosaur carnivorous or herbivorous?
- 5. Which dinosaurs are its predator?
- 6. If it's carnovorous which dinosaurs are its prey?
- 7. Write a diary entry for the day you discovered the bones.
- 8. Use a shoe box to make a model of your dinosaur's habitat and put a model of your dinosaur in it

Your finished work should include neat versions of:

A picture of the bones. An explanation of your dinosaur's name. A labelled drawing of your dinosaur, explaining its features. A description of where your dinosaur fits in the food chain (questions 4, 5 and 6). A neat diary entry about finding the day you found the dinosaur. Your shoebox model.
