

INVENT A DINOSAUR.

You have been on an archaeological dig and you have found new dinosaur bones.

1. Draw what the bones looked like when you found them in the ground.
2. Name your dinosaur and explain how you decided on the name i.e. where it was found, what you think it ate, what it may have looked like.
3. Draw a picture of what your dinosaur would have looked like when it was alive and give reasons for 4 of the features you have included.
4. Is your dinosaur carnivorous or herbivorous?
5. Which dinosaurs are its predator?
6. If it's carnivorous which dinosaurs are its prey?
7. Write a diary entry for the day you discovered the bones.
8. Use a shoe box to make a model of your dinosaur's habitat and put a model of your dinosaur in it

Your finished work should include neat versions of:

A picture of the bones. An explanation of your dinosaur's name. A labelled drawing of your dinosaur, explaining its features. A description of where your dinosaur fits in the food chain (questions 4, 5 and 6). A neat diary entry about finding the day you found the dinosaur. Your shoebox model.
